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Background:	For the past two years, the Public Safety Department's Police Athletic League (PAL) has been utilizing the Rockledge Presbyterian Church's passenger bus. Thank You for the opportunity for us to collaborate with the Rockledge Presbyterian Church in support of our local youth and the Rockledge Police Department's Police Athletic League.

Over the last 2 years, we have enjoyed a harmonious relationship with the church regarding the use of the Church bus for our PAL sponsored Basketball season. Please accept this correspondence as an agreement between the Church and the City for the use of your 14 passenger bus every Friday, October 5, 2018 through November 16, 2018. The usage would be from approximately 1330 hours to approximately 1630 hours. The church bus would be cleaned after each use and refueled on a regular basis. The travel consists of less than 25 total miles for each use. The bus will be driven by an on-duty sworn law enforcement officer who is dually licensed to operate said bus and who has also completed an extensive background investigation. The travel is between two elementary schools with 14 elementary school aged children who participate in the PAL program and have signed waivers to participate in said activity.

This agreement will indemnify the City of Rockledge and the Rockledge Police Department for said use of the Church bus during aforementioned use.
