1. CALL TO ORDER

The Council Administrative, Personnel & Community Relations Committee met on Wednesday, September 5, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber at Rockledge City Hall, 1600 Huntington Lane, Rockledge, Florida.

With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith.

2. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. Discussion: Potential Amendments to the Parking, Stopping and Standing Ordinance as Related to Orange Avenue

Chairman Smith indicated that the sole topic of the agenda was to discuss potential amendments to the Parking, Stopping and Standing Ordinance.

City Manager Fettrow noted that she and Public Safety Director LaSata have received mixed feedback from the residents with regard to the parking regulations that are in effect on Orange Avenue.

Chief LaSata provided background information on the Parking, Stopping and Standing Ordinance. A number of residents have been speaking with him concerning the no-parking signs – some residents want the signs to be removed, while others want them to remain in place. There are also concerns regarding Rockledge Regional Medical Center personnel utilizing Orange Avenue to park. Chief LaSata further noted that the reason for having this discussion was due to complaints received from residents.

City Manager Fettrow noted that she had received a petition signed by 13 individuals to not amend the Ordinance and to have the no-parking signs remain in place, since they have been in place for years and have been effective.

At this time, Chairman Smith declared the public comment period to be closed. Discussion ensued among Committee members, City Manager Fettrow and Director LaSata. City Manager Fettrow indicated that it would be her recommendation to not amend the ordinance, to have the signs remains in place, and to exclude holidays that fall on weekdays from any parking restrictions or time limitations; Director LaSata concurred.

***Committee Member Ferguson moved to recommend to Council to allow the parking restrictions to remain the same on Orange Avenue but to remove holidays that fall on a weekday from any limitations or restrictions on parking; seconded by Committee Member Martin. The motion carried without objection (3).***
