Background:	From time to time, the Public Safety Department will legally impound vehicles that have been confiscated and placed in the Department's impound lot. After completing a series of statutorily required steps, the vehicles are determined to be abandoned and become property of the City. Typically, these vehicles are scrapped for parts; however, on occasion, the vehicle(s) might actually be worth more than the scrap metal. In such instance, the City will take title to the vehicle(s) and, if declared as surplus by Council, will attempt to sell it/them.
