

RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - _____

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RECOMPUTED PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR 2019 AD VALOREM TAXES IN THE CITY OF ROCKLEDGE, AND PUBLICLY ANNOUNCING THE PERCENTAGE INCREASE IN PROPERTY TAXES TENTATIVELY ADOPTED BY THE ROCKLEDGE CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the Rockledge City Council heretofore advised the Brevard County Property Appraiser that the rolled back millage for the City of Rockledge for the year 2019 would be \$_____ per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation, and that the proposed millage rate for 2019 ad valorem taxes in the City of Rockledge was \$_____ per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation, and further advised said Property Appraiser of the date, time, and place at which a public hearing would be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the tentative budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065(2)(c), Florida Statutes, the Rockledge City Council has, at this meeting on the date stated below, conducted a public hearing on the tentative budget and proposed millage rate, and has recomputed said proposed millage rate, and desires to hereby publicly announce said recomputed proposed millage rate and the percentage by which said recomputed proposed millage rate exceeds the rolled back rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLEDGE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The recomputed proposed millage rate for 2019 ad valorem taxation in the City of Rockledge is hereby established at \$_____ per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation of properties subject to ad valorem taxation in the City of Rockledge.

SECTION 2. The percent by which said recomputed proposed millage rate of \$_____ per \$1,000.00 exceeds the rolled back rate of \$_____ per \$1,000.00 is _____%.

SECTION 3. The percentage increase in 2019 property taxes tentatively adopted by the Rockledge City Council is _____%.
