## Household Garbage



Consists of all kitchen waste, other household waste, and small miscellaneous garbage. Wheeled garbage container, the container is to be used **only for household garbage**. The garbage container must be placed curbside by 7:00am on your scheduled pick-up day and removed from the curb by 7:00pm the same day. If your container should need repair, please call the Sanitation Division at the number above.

Please help to maintain the life and cleanliness of your household garbage container by bagging all garbage and sanitizing it frequently. Large items such as furniture, mattresses, electronics, large amounts of construction debris, treated wood, etc., are considered **Special Pick-up** items and **MUST BE CALLED IN PRIOR TO NOON ON TUESDAY TO BE ADDED TO THE LIST. THESE TYPES OF ITEMS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP WITH THE REGULAR HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE.**

## Yard Trash



Yard Trash includes grass clippings, weeds, leaves, pine needles, shrubbery trimmings and tree branches cut up to 5 ft. lengths and stacked in the same direction, if possible, at the curb. Fruit from trees must be disposed of in your garbage container. Residents are required to purchase two reusable containers of a 30-32gal capacity, with handles and lids (wheels are optional but preferred). The two containers must be utilized for yard trash first before filling black lawn bags. The yard trash containers cannot weigh over 50lbs. with yard debris inside. The containers will be dumped and then used to place the empty plastic lawn bags into, which will prevent them

from blowing around the neighborhood. The plastic lawn bags can then be disposed of in your household garbage. The City is not responsible for any yard trash containers. The City does not pick-up dirt, rocks or sand with your yard trash. If you have sod or anything retaining dirt or sand, shake it completely out and spread it over your lawn. **ABSOLUTELY NO YARD TRASH IS PERMITTED IN THE GARBAGE CONTAINER**

## Recycle

**TIPS—PLEASE RINSE YOUR CANS, BOTTLES AND JARS. THROW AWAY CAPS AND LIDS.**



**RECYCLING MATERIALS ACCEPTED:** **PLASTICS:** Plastic containers with screw tops only, without caps. HDPE natural and pigmented containers with narrow necks only, without caps (milk, water, detergent and shampoo bottles, etc.). Plastics with narrow and screw top containers, plastic storage containers without the lid. **PAPER:** Old corrugated cardboard, regular cardboard, cereal boxes (all broken down), newsprint, magazines, catalogs, telephone books, printer paper, copier paper, mail, gable top containers (milk and juice cartons), aseptic (no refrigeration needed) boxes, including juice boxes and all other office paper without wax liners as well as paper bags. **ALUMINIUM:** Food and beverage containers, ferrous (iron) cans. **GLASS:** Food and beverage containers (brown, clear and green). **MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED:** Microwave trays, mirrors, window or auto glass, light bulbs, ceramics, porcelain, un-numbered plastics, plastic bags, coat hangers, glass cookware/bakeware, household items such as cooking pots, etc. Please remember to rinse all of your bottles and containers free of residue!! **ABSOLUTELY NO:** Plastic bags, film or wraps, pesticides and herbicides, pool chemicals, anti-freeze, motor oil containers, solvents, liquid paints and adhesives, medical supplies, flower pots, and shredded paper.

What is **HAZARDOUS WASTE**? It is defined as any substance that is corrosive, reactive, flammable or toxic. These chemicals pose a threat to people and our environment. When disposed improperly, they injure and/or pollute. Information of disposal regarding these materials not accepted by the City of Rockledge can be found by calling the Household Hazardous Waste facility at (321) 635-7954. The Household Hazardous Waste facility is at the Brevard County Landfill at 2250 Adamson Rd., Cocoa, Florida 32926.

-Unauthorized dumping into commercial dumpsters is illegal; if caught, you can be fined \$500.00 or placed in jail for 60 days. Simply call if you need a special pick-up.

The City of Rockledge has a Special Pick-up day every Wednesday, excluding holiday weeks with the exception of the week of Thanksgiving.

**Special Pickup items MUST be called in prior to noon on Tuesday to be added to the list. These types of items will not be picked up with the regular household garbage:** Large items such as furniture, mattresses, large amounts of Construction debris, treated wood, etc.

We will also **recycle electronics** such as: computers, laptops, monitors, keyboards, mice, scanners, printers, fax machines, stereos, speakers, radios, VCR's, televisions, etc.

We also pickup **appliances** such as: microwaves, blenders, toasters, dishwashers, washers, dryers, refrigerators and freezers (all doors must be off or secured)

**All items must be placed curbside by 7:00am. We cannot pick up these items from garages, carports or backyards.**
