Driveway and Pavers

- City of Rockledge Land Development Regulations
 - Part III. Procedures and Processes
 - Section 36.00 – Work Affecting Public Ways
 - It shall be unlawful to open, grade, pave, construct, make any excavation in, disturb the surface of, or do any other work affecting any street, sidewalk, or public way, or any curb or structure or fixture appurtenant to any street, sidewalk, or public way, or to install or construct any underground pipes, sewers, lines or utility installations of any character, without first obtaining a permit therefor from the director of public works. Sidewalks, curbs and driveway aprons located in city owned right-of-way shall not be painted or etched or use alternative construction materials or be otherwise modified from existing standards without the express approval of the Rockledge City Manager.
 - 36.03 – Application for permit
 - Any person desiring a permit pursuant to this section shall make written application to the director of public works stating the public way involved, the work to be done, and the time and place when the applicant desires to do the work described in the application. Except in the cases of an emergency, said application must be made no less than forty-eight (48) hours in advance of the time of commencement of the work, as stated in the application.

Documentation Required:

- Completed Permit Application
- Recorded Notice of Commencement if over \$2,500.00
- Survey/Site Plan showing location of driveway/pavers
- For the installation of pavers in the right-of-way City Manager Approval is required
- Owner/Builder Affidavit (if work is being done by Homeowner)**
