ROCKLEDGE MOTOR VEHICLE REGULATIONS

All motor vehicles that are kept in residential areas MUST have a current tag, registered to that vehicle, displayed in plain sight on the vehicle otherwise it is considered inoperable.

Inoperable vehicles may have one or more of the following items:

1. A vehicle with missing or expired tag
2. Unable to start or run under its own power
3. Any defect that would render it illegal to operate on the highway ie: No brakes, inoperative lights, broken windows etc.
4. No engine, missing wheels
5. One or more flat tire(s)
6. Major body parts missing
7. No seats

One (1) inoperable vehicle is allowed per property in a residential area, *if* the inoperable vehicle is kept in an enclosed building (garage). The only exception to this is if the vehicle is on the property for less than seven (7) days.

You are not allowed to store pieces or part of a vehicle outside, before, during, or after the work is done.
