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MAJOR RECREATIONAL EQUIPMENT

MOTORHOMES, 5th WHEEL & STANDARD TRAVEL TRAILERS, SLIDOUT CAMPERS, POP UP CAMPERS

Major recreational equipment must be parked behind the front building line in a side or back yard, provided that:

- 1. The resident of the property owns the equipment stored on the property.**
- 2. The equipment is used for recreational use only, by the resident.**
- 3. The equipment is stored only, and not used for sleeping, housekeeping, or living quarters.**
- 4. The equipment is not hooked up to electrical, water, or sewer connections except for purposes of testing or repair.**
- 5. The equipment is parked on an improved surface, such as asphalt, crushed stone, crushed shell, paving bricks, or concrete, not grass or dirt.**
- 6. Not more than one piece of recreational equipment is parked on the property.**
- 7. The equipment has a current tag displayed and valid registration.**

Major recreational equipment may be parked in a driveway for a period of 72 continuous hours during a thirty-day period, if the person in possession is visiting the property upon which the R.V. is parked. The equipment must be parked more than five (5) feet off the public right of way, and can not block sidewalks. Rules # 3, 4, 5 still apply.
