JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: CONSTRUCTION/CARPENTER I & II

DEPARTMENT: PUBLIC WORKS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Skilled work in the construction and maintenance of streets, sidewalks, stormwater facilities, driveways, and buildings. Work is performed under the general direction of the Coordinator - Construction/Maintenance. Difference between Construction/Carpenter I & II is the level of experience and application of skills.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

1. Performs maintenance of existing infrastructure such as stormwater facilities (pipes, stormwater inlets and spillways), sidewalks, roadway curbs, and roadways.
2. Constructs new infrastructure such as stormwater facilities, sidewalks, roadway curbs and roadways.
3. Installs traffic control devices such as speed humps and dips.
4. Constructs new buildings and parking facilities.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

- Knowledge of masonry practices and procedures.
- Knowledge of form construction.
- Knowledge of asphalt installation techniques.
- Ability to operate carpentry and other trade tools and equipment.
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.
- Skill in the use and care of tools, materials and equipment.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

High school graduation or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma. At least two (2) years experience as a skilled trades worker.

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS OR REGISTRATIONS:

Valid Florida Driver's License.
