JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: PAINT AND BODY TECHNICIAN

DEPARTMENT: PUBLIC WORKS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Skilled work in repairing and painting automotive equipment and minor and major body work. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Lead Paint and Body Technician.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

1. Performs paint and body work on automobiles, trucks, tractors, mowers and other heavy and light equipment. Performs filer glass repair. Replaces parts.
2. Performs corrosion and refinishing.
3. Assists mechanics in their work and performs the more routine repairs.
4. Installs decals and paints stripes.
5. Maintains garage area and paint booth in a clean and orderly condition.
6. Fabricates and welds.

(These essential job functions are not to be construed as a complete statement of all duties performed. Employees will be required to perform other job related marginal duties as required.)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

- Knowledge of the standard methods, practices, tools and equipment of the automotive body trade.
- Knowledge of the occupational hazards and safety precautions of the trade.
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

High school graduation or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma. Two (2) years of paint and body service work experience.

(A comparable amount of training, education or experience can be substituted for the minimum qualifications.)

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS OR REGISTRATIONS:

Valid Florida Driver's License.

ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL SKILLS:

- Acceptable eyesight (with or without correction).
- Acceptable hearing (with or without hearing aid).
- Heavy (45 pounds and over) lifting and carrying.
- Reaching.
- Climbing.
- Depth perception.
- Pulling.
- Pushing.
- Walking.
- Standing.
- Crawling.
- Kneeling.
- Bending.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS:

- Works inside.
- Works outside in various weather conditions with: noise, dust, fumes, grease or oils, solvents, paint, electrical energy.
- Slippery surfaces.
- With moving objects or vehicles.
