



**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

**KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:**

- Knowledge of the City ordinances and state statutes.
- Knowledge of principles and practices of sampling.
- Knowledge of Wastewater and industrial waste.
- Knowledge of State and Federal statutes as related to wastewater treatment, water reclamation.
- Ability to interpret technical designs.
- Ability to enforce city ordinances.
- Ability to work with the general public.
- Skill to use standard equipment and testing devices.
- Skill to correct defects and violations.
- Basic computer knowledge for data entry.

**EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:**

High School graduation or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma. Five (5) years experience within the wastewater treatment field.

(A comparable amount of training, education or experience can be substituted for the minimum qualification.)

**LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS OR REGISTRATIONS:**

Valid Florida Driver's License.  
Appropriate Wastewater Operators License (Min. Class "C")  
All requirements of the Florida State Statutes.

**ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL SKILLS:**

- Moderate (15 to 44 pounds) lifting and carrying.
- Distinguish colors.
- Acceptable eyesight (with or without correction).
- Acceptable hearing (with or without hearing aid).
- Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- Walking.
- Standing.
- Crawling.
- Kneeling.
- Bending.
- Balancing.
- Stooping.
- Driving.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS:**

- Works inside and out-of-doors in various weather conditions with noise, slippery surfaces, uneven surfaces.
